

**ORDINANCE ORDERING THE POSTING OF SIGNS
TO PROHIBIT THE CARRYING OF CONCEALED HANDGUNS
ON COUNTY PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, Chapter 398 of the 1995 Session Laws allows the carrying of concealed handguns by persons who have obtained a permit to do so from the Sheriff; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. § 14-415.23 permits local governments to adopt an ordinance ordering the posting of its property in accordance with N.C.G.S. § 14-415.11 which prohibits the carrying of concealed handguns in local government buildings, their appurtenant premises, and parks; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has found it to be expedient and in the interest of public safety to adopt an ordinance ordering the posting of signs to prohibit the carrying of concealed handguns on County property.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR THE COUNTY OF ALAMANCE DOTH ORDAIN:

1. The County Manager is hereby ordered to post signs on all buildings owned or controlled by the County of Alamance prohibiting the carrying of a concealed handgun in said buildings and appurtenant premises in accordance with N.C.G.S. § 14-415.11(c).
2. The County Manager is further ordered to post signs at Cedarock Park prohibiting the carrying of a concealed handgun in Cedarock Park in accordance with N.C.G.S. § 14-415.11(c).
3. This Ordinance shall be effective on and after December 1, 1995.
