Alamance County Board of Elections Director Kathy Holland was elected President of the North Carolina Association of Directors of Elections (NCADE) during the Associations recent conference. The conference was held April 27, 2021 – April 29, 2021 in a virtual format due to COVID 19.

The mission of the NCADE is to increase the proficiency of the Directors of Elections and staff, to enhance professionalism and improve the management practices and procedures in administering the election process.

Holland has served in various positions within the NCADE including vice-president, the nominating committee and the district representative for District 4.

Holland brings nearly 31 years of election experience to the position, serving at the Alamance County Board of Elections since June, 1990. During her tenure at the Board of Elections she has served on many committees and special projects with the State Board of Elections, some of which include the original rollout of the SEIMS (State Election Information Management System) in 1998, the inaugural Election Resource Center project, the Precinct Uniformity Projects, and the Records Retention Review Committee with the NC Department of Cultural Resources.

Holland is a Certified North Carolina Election Administrator. She received her Certified Election/Registration Administrator Certification in 2010 from The Election Center/Auburn University and completed the UNC School of Government County Administration program in 2014.
