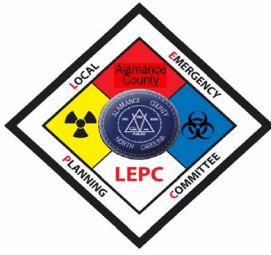


Alamance County Q2 LEPC Meeting Agenda

- Open Meeting
- Secretary's Report
 - Report out of businesses that have completed their yearly report- William King
 - Currently 489 out of 702 facilities have reported. State/EPA audit coming and noncompliant facilities could be in trouble.
 - Report out of Percentage Collected for previous year- William King
 - Collected 95.25% for 23 and 49.14% of outstanding balances from previous years. \$8,018.60 out in overdue now.
- Lessons Learned
 - Encourage industry to share results from investigations, inspections, internal or external audits, certifications, awards, commendations, recognition, etc.

 - Local Fire Departments- None
 - Local Law Enforcement- ACSO has purchases drones now available for response on each patrol shift.
