



The Alamance County Family Justice Center is launching it's first specialized youth programming to foster pathways to hope and healing for youth who experienced domestic violence and trauma!







Camp HOPE America is the first evidence-based camping and mentoring program in the United States to focus on children and teens exposed to domestic violence. Children who are exposed to trauma such as domestic violence are more likely to experience health, social, and legal disparities as adults. *The mission is to give traumatized youth a brighter future by creating pathways to hope and healing.*

Camp Hope is a weeklong overnight camping adventure for children. While at camp, youth explore high adventure activities that help them overcome fears and try new things in a safe, supportive setting. Youth participate in collaborative, team-building activities and learn what it means to believe in themselves, each other, and their dreams. Most importantly, children who typically live very stressful lives get the chance to know the simple joys of childhood.

In addition to summer camp, youth participate in monthly enrichment activities throughout the year. By participating in these specialized programming opportunities, they build community with peers, heal from trauma, and learn new skills like communication, teamwork, problem solving, goal setting, curiosity play, and creativity.

Without Camp Hope, many children would never have the opportunity to experience summer camp and would miss their best chance to develop a healthy sense of self and hope for the future. All children deserve to have a childhood, and all children should know life doesn't have to be filled with violence. Programming is offered at no cost to youth and their families and sponsorship opportunities are available! Together, we can break the cycle of violence and change the destinies of children impacted by domestic violence.
