WIFI HOTSPOTS ARE NOW AVAILABLE FROM THE ALAMANCE COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARIES!

The Alamance County Public Libraries are proud to begin offering Wi-Fi hotspots for circulation through our Creating Connections program. This is made possible by the State Library of North Carolina CARES grant funds provided by the federal Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS).

Hotspots will be available for check out for 28 days to patrons 17 years of age or older with a library card in good standing. Internet access via library hotspots and the quality of access are subject to the availability of cell phone coverage, of which the library has no control. All aspects of the Alamance County Public Library Internet Access Policy apply when using a library hotspot.

Hotspots can be requested in-person at the library, by calling during service hours to get on the hold list, or through the library catalog. Immediate availability is not guaranteed.

Our service hours:

- Mondays, Wednesdays, & Fridays: 10:00 a.m. 2:00 p.m.
- Tuesdays and Thursdays:

Senior Access: 1:00 – 2:00 p.m.
 General Access: 2:00 – 6:00 p.m.

All patrons are encouraged to follow the "Three Ws" as outlined by the N.C. Dept. of Health and Human Services – WEAR a face covering; WAIT in line at least six feet away from others, and WASH hands frequently or use hand sanitizer. If you are experiencing symptoms of illness, the Library asks that you postpone your visit.
