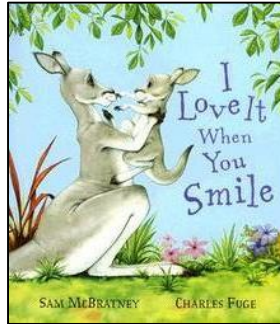

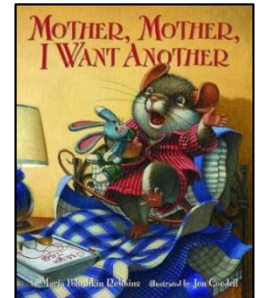
A grumpy little kangaroo is having a bad day until his mother finds a way to make him smile.



Parents, you are your child's first and best teacher. Here are five simple practices to help children get ready to read.



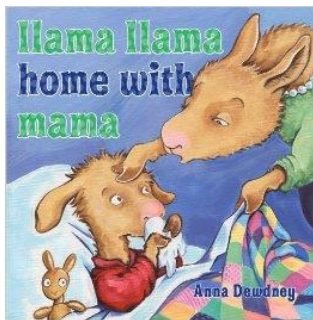
Look for words everywhere. The stop sign, the grocery store.... Kids LOVE pointing out letters!
