WINTER READING BOARD GAME

HOW TO PLAY:

1. Roll your die and beginning from the "Start" position, count that number of circles.
2. Complete the challenge listed on the circle and place one of your stickers on the circle once you are done. For example, if you roll a 4, you will read a book with a blue cover, and place a sticker on the circle when you've finished your book.
3. After your first challenge is completed, repeat steps 1-2 and move along the game board until you reach "Finish".
4. When you've landed on "Finish", congratulations! You've won Winter Reading. Please bring your completed game board to any library location to claim your prize. We will be distributing Winter Reading prizes until MARCH 1.
5. Want to play the game again? You can ask library staff for a fresh game board. Subsequent finished game boards are eligible to be returned to the library for a small prize.

Remember, audiobooks and graphic novels are considered books too!

Special note: We did our best to make this game board for all ages. We understand if you need to adapt a challenge for a younger reader!
