

Fishing at Cedarrock Park

Requirements

Every adult (16 years and older) fishing at Cedarrock Park must:

- Have a valid N.C. Fishing License (including any minors for which you are responsible)
- Purchase a Cedarrock Park Fishing Pass:
 - Daily Passes are \$5.00, Annual Passes are \$25.00
 - Passes are available for purchase at the Cedarrock Shop & Visitors Center. Carry both your license and pass with you when you fish.

Regulations

Catch limit of **6 fish total per day, per fishing pass. Daily catch limit for trout is 4 fish.** (If you have minors fishing with you, their catch applies to your daily catch limit). No catch & release of trout- if you catch a trout, you must keep it.

Frequently Asked Questions

- What fish are available in the ponds?
 - Year-round: Bream and Catfish
 - Winter months: Trout
- Why do I have to pay to fish at the park?
 - The fee allows us to provide more fishing variety and improve your fishing experience.
- How do I purchase a Cedarrock Park Fishing Pass?
 - Please visit the Cedarrock Shop & Visitors Center (middle parking lot, near the pond). Our staff will assist you.
- What if I lose my Cedarrock Park Fishing Pass?
 - We keep a record of all annual pass purchases. If you forget your pass, please check in at the office and a staff member will assist you. One replacement pass per year will be provided at no charge.
- How do I purchase a N.C. Fishing License?
 - N.C. Fishing Licenses may be purchased online, by phone, or at select local businesses (including Alamance County Walmart stores).
