Alamance County Sheriff's Office in Reference to the November 28, 2020 Demonstration

According to an anonymous recording received by the Alamance County Sheriff's Office, a demonstration is expected to be held in downtown Graham on Saturday, November 28, 2020.

The recording that was received by the Sheriff's Office is from the Thursday, November 19 Community Meeting for Unification. While the Sheriff's Office recognizes that some of the message from last night was peace, part of the recording was cause for concern. At one point, Mr. Drumwright states, "I'm here to announce that, yes, we will march again and while we may not all agree on a march, what we need to understand is that, it's either at this point, a march or a riot. We work with others, we're at war."

The Sheriff's Office strongly encourages all those that attend the November 28 demonstration to refrain from harming people and property, blocking streets and intersections, and trespassing, as these actions are illegal and can result in arrest.

While the Sheriff's Office supports and respects an individual's constitutional right to free speech, we continue to ask everyone to exercise those rights in a peaceful and respectful manner.
