**Alamance County Sheriff's Office in Reference to a Statement Made Prior  
to the Rev. Drumwright Press Conference from 12-2-20**

On Wednesday, December 2, Reverend Drumwright conducted a press conference at the J.B. Allen Courthouse before his 2:00 p.m. bond modification hearing with the district attorney. Prior to the start of the conference, the Sheriff's Office was alerted to a statement with a participant in the audience. Since then, the Sheriff's Office has received numerous inquiries from concerned residents regarding what was said.

The person speaking was recorded by WFMY News 2, and the full recording is available on their facebook page at <https://fb.watch/28NB6mh4vW/>. The referenced quote below begins on minute eleven and sixteen seconds.

"If, if - they better understand before they try to ban him, is that Pastor Drumwright is the peacemaker. He's - he's holding back, not holding back, but he's subduing a lot of young activists that want to do other things. So if you take him away you're leaving room for some of us to come in and really shake some shit up, alright, okay? Alright. Cause if we come shake shit up the way we want to, we coming with, with some pieces. Right. And we follow Drumwright's lead, you may want to keep him here. It'll help ya'll. It will be in their best interest to keep him here so that other young activists will follow him... cause we're tired of marching at this point... you know what I mean?"

The Alamance Sheriff's Office intel staff has identified the speaker as Regis Kishon Green who was charged on October 31 for failure to disperse as well as on November 16 for resisting a law enforcement officer, disorderly conduct in a public building, and disruption of an official meeting.

The Sheriff's Office will continue to monitor and share any credible threats of violence from anyone with our community. While we continue to support peaceful demonstrators, we want to remind everyone that violence and destruction are not the answer.
